Public Acts of 1976 Chapter 424

COMPILER'S NOTE; The following act is a public act of special application and is not codified in Tennessee Code Annotated.

SECTION 1. It shall be lawful to hunt and take deer in Marshall County with a rifle shotgun, or with a bow and arrow.

As amended by: Private Acts of 1977, Chapter 253

SECTION 2. This Act shall take effect on becoming a law, the public welfare requiring it.

Passed: February 16, 1976.
