RESOLUTION FIXING THE TAX LEVY IN \_\_\_\_\_COUNTY, TENNESSEE FOR THE YEAR BEGINNING JULY 1, 20\_\_

SECTION 1. BE IT RESOLVED by the Board of County Commissioners ofCounty, Tennessee, assembled in regular session on this 18th day of July, 20, that the combined proper rate forCounty, Tennessee for the year beginning July 1, 20, shall be \$1.5341 on \$100 of taxable property, which is to provide revenue for each of the following funds and otherwist conform to the following levies:	each

General \$	0.5568
General Purpose School	0.6987
General Debt Service	0.0855
Rural Debt Service \$	0.1931
Total <u>\$</u>	1.5341
SECTION 2. BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that there is hereby levied a gross receipts tax as provide The proceeds of the gross receipts tax herein levied shall accrue to the General Fund.  SECTION 3. BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that all resolutions of the Board of County Commissioners	·
County, Tennessee, which are in conflict with this resolution are hereby repealed.	
SECTION 4. BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that this resolution take effect from and after its passage public welfare requiring it. This resolution shall be spread upon the minutes of the Board of Count Commissioners.
