Public Acts of 1871 Chapter 10

SECTION 1. That the County Line between the Counties of Campbell and Claiborne be changes as follows: Commencing on lot line "G". of Henderson & Co., Powell's Valley large survey, where the County line crosses the same; thence with said lot line north about 27° west to George W. Cooper's land; then with said Cooper's line, so as to include all the lands of George W. Cooper and J. B. Little in Campbell County. This Act to take effect from and after its passage, the public welfare requiring it.

Passed: October 26, 1871.
