Private Acts of 1951 Chapter 248

COMPILER'S NOTE: See also T.C.A. 8-24-102 for the current minimum compensation of the County Executive.

SECTION 1. That hereafter in counties having a population of not less than 15,585, nor more than 15,615, according to the Federal Census of 1940, or any subsequent Federal Census, the County Judge of said county shall receive in addition to his regular salary now allowed by law, an additional sum of Twelve Hundred (\$1,200.00) Dollars per annum, for his administrative duties and for his services as fiscal agent of said county, the same to be paid monthly from the general county funds. As amended by: Private Acts of 1953, Chapter 452

SECTION 2. That this Act shall take effect from and after its passage, the public welfare requiring it.
