# Public Acts of 1973 Chapter 119

**COMPILER'S NOTE:** The following act is a public act of special application and is not codified in Tennessee Code Annotated.

**SECTION 1.** Whenever there is an error in the Trustee's books in regard to the receiving and recording of a tax payment, when the same occurs as the result of a clerical or bookkeeping error, or any other error material to the receiving and properly recording of a tax payment, the Trustee shall make the necessary corrections and report the difference, if any, in his release list. This Act shall only apply to those counties with populations over 600,000 according to the 1970 Federal Census, and to counties having a population of not less than 44,000 nor more than 45,000 by the Federal Census of 1970 or any subsequent Federal Census.

**SECTION 2.** All laws or parts of laws in conflict with this Act are hereby repealed.

**SECTION 3.** This Act shall take effect upon becoming law, the public welfare requiring it.

Passed: April 25, 1973.
