## Public Acts of 1970 Chapter 371

**COMPILER'S NOTE:** The following act is a public act of special application and is not codified in Tennessee Code Annotated.

**SECTION 1.** It is unlawful to use any electrical or electronic device for the purpose of calling foxes in Sevier County. Violation of this Act is a misdemeanor, punishable as provided by general law.

SECTION 2. This Act shall take effect on becoming a law, the public welfare requiring it.
