## **REQUIREMENTS FOR CEREMONY BY VIDEO CONFERENCE, if applicable:**

A member of the armed forces of the United States may appear at the marriage ceremony via video conferencing if:

- (1) The member of the armed forces is stationed in another country in support of combat or another military operation;
- (2) A commissioned officer is present with, and confirms the identity of, the member of the armed forces;
- (3) A person authorized to solemnize marriages pursuant to § 36-3-301 is present with, and confirms the identity of, the person who is marrying the member of the armed forces; and
- (4) The person who is marrying the member of the armed forces is present in Tennessee.

***If the ceremony is to be performed by video conference, the applicant must so indicate in the affidavit. Otherwise, the marriage ceremony must be performed with both parties personally appearing before the officiant as required by § 36-3-302.***
